Our grapes are picked at night to maximize acidity and taken to the winery no later than 7:00 AM to be pressed off the skins, stems, and seeds. After a day of settling and racking clean, wine is cold-fermented over a 45-day period to maximize flavor retention. The 2017 vintage has aromas of stone fruit and fresh apple on the nose with a hint of baking spices. The wine's texture is both enveloping and bright. Fuji apple, Meyer lemon and lychee are followed by honeycomb and brioche. The finish lingers from the front through the back of the palate, balanced by its richness and acidity.
