"A beautiful 2014 Cabernet Sauvignon with notes of plum, blueberry, black raspberry and the telltale blackcurrant. "Reminiscent of some of the old-style Chardonnays in that it is explosively rich, with plenty of tropical fruit, peach marmalade and honeysuckle, but to its credit, there is little oak to be found. This is just beautifully pure fruit and one could call it (and I mean this in a positive sense) a Chardonnay fruit bomb.
