Mixed and macerated soft fruits, mocha and blue wildflowers greet the nose. Firm tannins are balanced with focused mid palate weight and a lively acidity both front and back. Roasted Mission figs and pomegranate dominate. The primary fruit flavors are well integrated with toffee, licorice root and an earthy forest component. This wine consistently portrays the classic traits of a tried and true Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon.
